NORTH MARIN WATER DISTRICT REGULATION 13

LOOP EXTENSIONS BY THE DISTRICT

If the Board of Directors finds that an interconnection between two of its water mains will benefit the District, it may, in its sole discretion, construct said interconnection without entering into a main extension agreement and without all or portion of the costs thereof being advanced by an application for water service as provided by Regulations 22 through 26. The costs of such extension shall be allocated among the various parcels of lands susceptible of service therefrom on such fair basis as shall be determined by the General Manager and approved by the Board of Directors, taking into consideration the area of each parcel, its potential water requirements and its frontage, if any, on the said interconnection. Said allocated cost shall be paid to the District prior to the commencement of water service to said parcel of land and shall be in addition to the initial charges for service required by Regulation 1 c.
