## RAINWATER HARVESTING REBATE PROGRAM

Rainwater harvesting is the collection and storage of untreated rainwater for reuse. Rainwater harvesting ranges from simple catchment devices, such as rain barrels, to more complex systems such as cisterns and storage tanks. Thanks to partial funding from the Marin County Stormwater Pollution Prevention Program, starting May 2024, the District will rebate \$0.75 per gallon of storage for rainwater harvesting projects with a minimum of 100 gallons of storage and a maximum rebate of \$2,000.00. The rebate can not exceed the cost of materials (labor not included) or \$2,000, whichever is less.

### **PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

#### Applicants must:

- Be a customer within the NMWD's Novato or West Marin service areas.
- Agree to a brief pre- and post-installation inspection.
- Submit a detailed design plan for the rainwater catchment system.
- Agree to have a District backflow protection device installed at a cost to the applicant/customer.
- Install the rainwater catchment system between January 1, 2024 and December 31, 2024.

#### **System Requirements:**

- Install a system with a minimum of 100 gallons of storage.
- System must have vector controls to prohibit mosquito breeding.
- Catchment devices must be covered and all vents and inlets must have fine mesh screens to prevent debris from entering the device.

#### How can I participate?

- **Step 1:** Call NMWD's Water Conservation Office at (415) 761-8944 and schedule a brief preinspection.
- Step 2: Submit a detailed plan for approval to District staff. After pre-inspection and plan approval, proceed with the rainwater catchment system installation. *Rebates are issued only for projects approved in advance.*
- **Step 3:** Schedule a post-installation inspection upon completion of project.
- **Step 4:** Mail in your application along with any applicable receipts (make copies for your own files) dated no earlier than January 1, 2024.
- **Step 5:** Rebate payment will be mailed to you in 3 to 4 weeks.
