

Mr. Eichstaedt has more than 40 years of technical engineering expertise with utility systems, roadways, environmental clean-ups and civil infrastructure. He is well-versed in taking projects from initial evaluation and planning, through design, and ultimately into final construction. Important water related projects he has worked includes East Bay Municipal Utility District's (EBMUD) \$200 million Seismic Improvement Program (SIP) that made major progress to increase the seismic reliability of the region's water supply; and, the San Francisco Public Utility District's Water System Improvement Program (WSIP), a \$4.8 billion-dollar, multi-year capital program to repair, replace, and seismically upgrade crucial portions of the Hetch Hetchy Regional Water System. He retired from the City of Petaluma serving as the Traffic Engineer. Previously, he worked for Harding Lawson Associates (Novato), URS/AECOM(SF) and was the General Manager for a water company on the coast.
